Background:

This position will be involved in the tobacco control work of the International Union Against Tuberculosis and Lung Disease (The Union). This program is funded by Bloomberg Philanthropies and is designed to implement best practices of tobacco control policies at the global level. The post holder will be based in New York City, and employed by Vital Strategies, an affiliate of The Union. Applicants must have a valid work permit to work in New York City.

Specific Duties:

- Support the Director and Deputy Directors in liaising with country and regional teams in the global program implementation and partner coordination.
- Support the Deputy Director in the monitoring of the tobacco industry and interpret the industry fallacies from scientific point of view.
- Support the Deputy Director in the monitoring of the debate around e-cigarettes and new products.
- Support the Deputy Director in the monitoring of the scientific literature on all tobacco control issues and provide summary updates for the Department.
- Support the Director of Tobacco Control in day-to-day functioning of the Tobacco Control Department;
- Lead the Tobacco Control Department in monthly, quarterly, and annual reporting to Bloomberg Philanthropies.
- The incumbent will report to the Director of Tobacco Control Department at The Union;
- This position will be based in New York City;
- Other duties as required by the Director of the Tobacco Control Department;
- Competitive compensation commensurate with education and experience will be provided.

Qualifications and Skill Set:

- Master Degree of Public Health required;
- Minimum 5 years' work experience in the field of public health, prior experience of working in international settings strongly preferred;
- Strong research capacity;
- Excellent communication skills, both face-to-face and in writing;
- Fluency in written and spoken English, fluency in another foreign language a plus;
- Organized, responsive, attentive to details, and collaborative;
- Up to 10% of travel is required.
